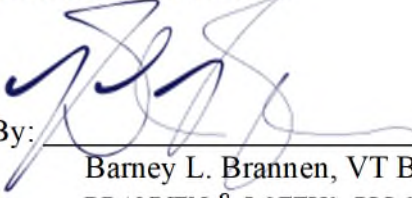
TRINI BRASSARD'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION
