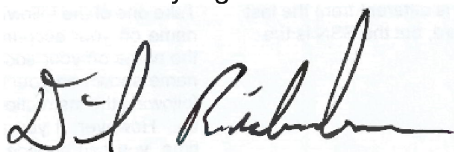
Judge's Entries: Brassards have delivered responses, but there are objections. 1) There is a confidentiality agreement/order circulating about issues. Defendant Trini Brassard: represents that she proposed confidentiality, but there are now additional issues. The problem is that there are multiple parties, and no one has really had their eye on advancing the discovery ball as efforts have focused on resolution or other issues. Time is now ripe to push forward and complete discovery. Parties have 15 days to work out confidentiality agreement that allows the financial information to be exchanged in a way that addresses and deals with confidentiality issues. Court to set this matter for a status conference in 30 days to address any outstanding issues or to check-in on the progress of discovery as it evolves in light of the agreements and process put into place.

Order: Parties have 15 days to work out confidentiality agreement/protective order; pending this deadline, Plaintiff's motion to compel is held in abeyance, and Defendant Trini Brassard's obligation to respond is stayed. Court will hold a status in approximately 30 days to check-in with parties on their discovery progress. Plaintiff shall work with all Defendants in developing confidentiality agreements/protective orders that preserve privacy while also making the information available to them for the limited purpose of litigation.
