TRINI BRASSARD'S NOTICE RE: ADDITIONAL TIME FOR
AUGUST 12, 2024 MOTION HEARING

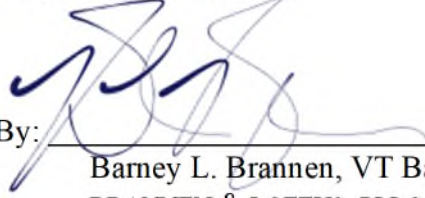
Pursuant to the Court's *Entry Regarding Motion*, dated July 30, 2024, Defendant, Trini Brassard ("Ms. Brassard"), by and through her attorneys, Brannen & Loftus, PLLC, hereby notifies the Court that the two (2) hours allotted for the August 12, 2024 Motion Hearing is insufficient time to resolve Plaintiff's request for a writ of attachment against Ms. Brassard's real property. Given that Plaintiff is required to demonstrate "a reasonable likelihood" that he will succeed on his claims against Ms. Brassard to secure said writ, V.R.C.P. Rule 4.1(b)(2), Ms. Brassard anticipates both the extensive use of exhibits and the need for testimony from all the parties in this matter. As such, Ms. Brassard respectfully requests the Court schedule Plaintiff's motion for a full-day hearing as the Court's calendar allows.¹

¹ As noted in *Trini Brassard's Memorandum in Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Ex Parte Attachment*, dated July 26, 2024, at pg. 1, FN 1, Ms. Brassard still believes the parties can reach (and, potentially, have reached) a mutually agreeable resolution as to Plaintiff's request for a writ of attachment that will obviate the need for the August 12, 2024 Motion Hearing. However, given that Plaintiff's counsel is away on vacation until August 5, 2024,
