TRINI BRASSARD'S RESPONSE TO
PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR A DISCOVERY CONFERENCE
(Filed June 27, 2024)

Trini Brassard ("Ms. Brassard"), by and through her attorneys, Brannen & Loftus, PLLC, does not agree with the Plaintiff's characterizations of historical communications between the parties or their counsel regarding discovery, but, as she does not object to Plaintiff's request for a discovery conference, she will not belabor the point here with a lengthy written "objection" to *Plaintiffs' Motion for a Discovery Conference*. Ms. Brassard does note, however, and objects to Plaintiff's catch-all request for "all other such relief as this Court deems just and appropriate," specifically to the extent Plaintiff seeks "costs and attorneys' fees." Inasmuch as there is no provision in V.R.C.P. 26(f) for awarding "costs and attorneys' fees" on a motion for a discovery conference, it appears this request for relief does not demand a specific response.
